

## UK Amateur Pole Performer 2010 Entry form

This competition is organised for Pole Dancers, by Pole Dancers.

This amateur section is purely for amateur pole performers and dancers. We class an Amateur dancer as someone who has been a student at home or at a school, who has never earned any money from pole Fitness, Dancing, Stripping, podium or any kind of performance or teaching of pole exercise. If a participant is found to have earned money from this then they will be immediately disqualified.

The instructor section is purely for Pole Instructors only, This section is for instructors who have worked their way from student to instructor, or have learnt at home and now instruct. You cannot have earned any money from performing pole or stripping. ( Proof may be asked for )

### Rules and Regulations:

#### **General Rules:**

- All applicants must be over 18
- This competition is open to all genders.
- All applicants must be available for the final on the 25<sup>th</sup> September 2010
- You understand that UKAPP will be taking pictures and videos and this may be used ( in good taste ) in all advertising for future events, all rights are reserved by UKAPP.
- All applicants are expected to conduct themselves in an acceptable manner at all times.
- You must not be under the influence of drink or drugs.
- The Organisers reserve the right to disqualify any person taking part if they feel that the rules have been broken.

#### **Competition performance rules:**

- All performances need to be clean fun, no butt slapping and boob rubbing.
- No thongs.
- You may take clothing off such as costumes to dance however you must have suitable outfits underneath,
- No nipple tassels unless attached to a bra.
- If the dance is thought to be too suggestive you will be marked down for it.
- Judges decision is final
- You must enter a heat to win a place in the final.
- The song must be no more than 3 min long for Amateur 4 min for Instructor.
- No fire or explosives allowed within the act
- Depending on the level each section will be judged on the following:

#### **Level 1 - The Performer**

Costume, Theme, Fluidity, Spin Smoothness, Dance Routine, **Crowd interaction**, Fun Factor.

#### **Level 2 - The Intermediate**

You will not be allowed to do the following tricks.

Death Lay, Knee Hold, Super Hold, Split Holds, Straight Edge, Hand Spring.

You will be marked on,

Trick smoothness, ( no point in doing a trick if it's not perfect )

Full List will be given in once your application has been accepted.

#### **Level 3- The Advanced**

Anything Goes

This section will be marked on TRICKS, fun factor, Fluidity, theme and over all tricks and dance transitions.

You will be marked on everything you do.....

**Level 4 – The Instructor.-**

Anything goes..

This section will be marked on EVERYTHING you do, Style, Fluidity, Theme, Fun and Theatrical factor, TRICKS. This section is Purely for NON performing Instructors. You may have performed for charity for free no more than 3 times. Also you may have performed at school events. However you may not have a regular performance job or belong to a dance agency.

Any Person seen to have given false information will be disqualified.....

**Heats and Final**

The winner and runner up from each amateur heat will go through to the final.

The winner of the Instructor heat will go through to the final.

If you have entered a competition as a Professional then you will be placed in the Instructor category. You will NOT be allowed in the Amateur section

There is an extra space up for grabs.

The judges decision on best OVERALL performance and effort will also be awarded a place in the final.

If any Judge has a student in the competition they will not be allowed to judge that contestant.

UK Amateur Pole Performer reserve the right to refuse any entry, also to disqualify any contestant who they think may have broken the rules in way.

UK Amateur Pole Performer organizers accept no responsibility for any injury, or accident that may occur.

Any contestant will also understand that the organisers and any third party involved will not be held responsible for any injuries incurred participating, attending as a spectator or travel to and from heats or finals.
